Wild Oak, the site of our Winery in Sonoma Valley, was named to honor Sonoma's Heritage Oak trees. Wild Oak wines by St. Francis are created from grapes that have been hand-picked from small lots of elite terroir bordered by these Heritage Oaks throughout Sonoma County. Wild Oak Zinfandel is true to classic Sonoma County style, representing a selection of family owned "old vines" vineyards located within the county's most renowned Zinfandel producing regions. Dry Creek Valley is the home of over 50% of this Zinfandel. Zinfandel grown in this appellation contributes the black cherry flavors typical of the dry farmed vineyards of the area. The remaining Zinfandel components come from the Russian River Valley and Sonoma Valley, each imparting their unique qualities. A small amount of Syrah from our estate Wild Oak vineyard is added, providing a flavorful counterpoint of earthiness to the ultimate blend.

The 2007 vintage displays a stunning hue of deep purple with intense aromas of fig and raspberries. A flavorful mid-palate of jam and spice compliment the finish with notes of minerality and lightly toasted oak.
